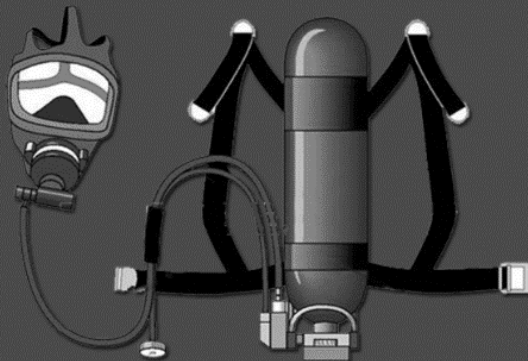
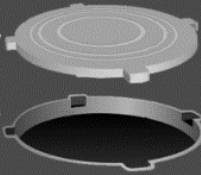
Requirements for Working Safely in **CONFINED SPACES**

Confined spaces are one of the most dangerous work environments; therefore, it is vital that operatives in these areas are adequately trained and equipped with the advanced safety products.

Define confined space?

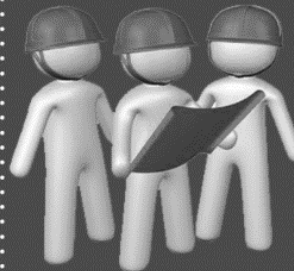
A "confined space" is any chamber, tank, manhole, vat, silo, pit, pipe, flue or any other enclosed space, in which:

- The supply of air is inadequate,
- There is a risk of engulfment by material.



Work Safely In Confined Space

When any person enters or carries out any work in a confined space, the Employer and/or Principal shall comply with the regulations strictly.



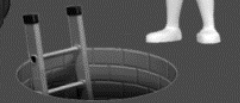
Identification/Record /Information of all confined spaces at the workplace;

Evaluation of the need for entry into the confined space;

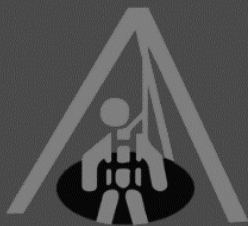
Safe means of access to and egress from the confined space;

Safe practices for opening the entrance of a confined space;

Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus.



Confined Space Working Statistics
