6 Tips to Keep Cargo Securement Tie-Downs in Proper Working Condition

Cover Up the Corners

Use corner protectors to protect straps and cargo from damage.



Clean, Dry and Store

Rinse or soak in water, Do not use bleach, harsh chemicals or brushing. If straps cannot be cleaned with a mild detergent, they should be replaced.



Keep Equipment Dry

Keeping chains, webbing and hardware dry is important to maintaining their integrity.



Get the Tough Stuff

Use tie-downs with extra abrasionresistant webbing to secure difficult loads.



5 Don't Let Them Drag

Keep your straps off the ground and secure excess webbing to prevent damage.



Know When to Replace

Examine tie-downs and other cargo control equipment before every load to make sure they are in safe working condition.
