Overhead Crane Hand Signals

HOIST THE LOAD
LOWER THE LOAD
STOP
BRIDGE TRAVEL
TROLLEY TRAVEL

Signals adapted from ASME B30.2-2005 (Overhead and Gantry Cranes)
Special operations may require modifications of these signals. ALL signals shall be agreed upon and understood by the signalperson and the crane operator.

MOVE SLOWLY

Use one hand to give any motion signal and hold the other hand motionless in front. (example shows hoist slowly)

MAGNET IS DISCONNECTED

Crane Operator ONLY
Spread both hands apart, palms up.

EMERGENCY STOP

ALL STOP!
An emergency stop signal must be accepted from any person.

MULTIPLE TROLLEYS

Hold up ONE finger for the block marked "1" and TWO fingers for the block marked "2". Then follow with regular hand signals.
