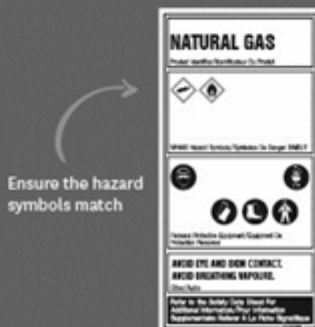


## SAFETY DATA SHEET

The Safety Data Sheet includes important information on the chemical properties, the physical, health and environmental hazards, and safety precautions for handling, storing and transporting the product. You always want to verify your SDS, as chemical names may be the same but their hazards and PPE symbols may vary depending on manufacturer.

### 02 Hazard Identification

The second section of your SDS will list any hazards of the product and will display the matching GHS hazard pictogram/symbol with precautionary statements relating to the type of hazard(s). If a product is not hazardous, this section will not contain any hazard info.
