

Supermarket: Lockout/Tagout (7 min.)



Failure to lock out and tag machinery before working on it is a major cause of injury and death in the United States. Workers can be electrocuted or lose fingers, hands, arms, or suffer severe crushing injuries because machinery is inadvertently turned on while being serviced or maintained. Lockout/Tagout prevents these injuries. This short program is designed to explain basic lockout/tagout procedures, some terminology used in the procedures and general requirements.
