BE READY FOR THE ROAD

Before you hit the road make sure that you and your tow truck are properly ready to handle the task at hand. Inspect the vehicle and equipment so you know that everything is in working order.



DRIVE SAFELY

CONTROL THE SITUATION

Once you arrive to your destination take control of the situation by turning on your safety lights, laying down cones, using flares and markers and getting people out of harms way. When towing away from the scene make sure the area is clear.



BE SEEN BY THE PUBLIC

Wear the appropriate uniform to indicate to the public that you are a tow truck driver. Use flashing lights and reflectors to indicate your presence.



DON'T OVERWORK IT

Only do what you and your tow truck can handle. Never tow a vehicle that is over your tow truck's capacity.
