

Tractor Hitching – Tow Chain Best Practices Picture This



The overturned tractor and attached implement suggest unsafe towing or hitching practices, likely involving an improper tow chain setup or attachment point. When chains are connected too high or to unstable parts, the risk of rollover increases drastically, especially on uneven or soft terrain.

Always use tow chains rated for the load and connect them to manufacturer-approved low hitch points to prevent rear overturns. Inspect chains before use, avoid sudden movements during towing, and never exceed recommended load capacities. Operators must be trained in safe recovery and towing techniques.
